There are so many conventions out there it can sometimes be confusing. But here is a hand where having the right agreements made the auction simple.

BIDDING: Holding a huge hand, South opened with an artificial forcing bid. North's response showed a six-card club suit headed by two of the top three honors. In response to South's heart bid, North jumped to the four level to show heart support along with spade shortness. South then used Roman Keycard Blackwood to find the ace of diamonds and bid the grand slam.

PLAY: West led the jack of diamonds and declarer quickly claimed all of the tricks. Note the grand slam in notrump is better than in hearts not just because it scores better, but also because it still succeeds when the hearts break badly. This was not a difficult slam to bid but it's easier with the right tools.

Giving meaning to a bid that is not otherwise used makes a lot of sense. Here is an opportunity that comes up very rarely and this partnership was ready for it.

BIDDING: North jump in the opponents' suit asked South to bid 3NT with a spade stopper. South was certainly nervous but did as he was asked.

PLAY: East won the low spade lead with the king and returned a low spade to the jack and ace. West saw he could not defeat the contract but did not want to give away overtricks. With this in mind, he made a club shift trying to hold declarer to nine tricks. Declarer won the ace of clubs and followed with the ace of diamonds. When the jack dropped, declarer led a diamond to his hand, cashed the spade queen, and ran the rest of the diamonds for ten tricks and +430. Those who ended in the more obvious contract of 5  were held to +400.

Note that an original club lead would have held declarer to nine tricks. A passive diamond opening lead would allow a bold declarer to get to his hand with a second diamond and lead toward the king of hearts for the overtrick. Matchpoints is not a game for the timid

Here's a hand where another rarely used convention solved a bidding problem.

***Grand Slam Force**

BIDDING: North was still counting his points when he saw his partner make a preempt in spades. Since they were vulnerable against non-vulnerable opponents, North was confident his partner would have a good spade suit, but to make sure, he employed the Grand Slam Force convention. This leap to 5NT asked South to bid seven with two of the top three spade honors. South complied and the grand slam was quickly reached.

PLAY: It didn't matter what West led as there was no way to defeat the slam. Another good method of bidding the grand slam would be to use Roman Keycard Blackwood. This convention allows you to uncover both the king and queen of the trump suit. Lacking such tools, can you be confident your partner didn't open with this spade suit: KJ1098754? Or perhaps QJ10987542? It's usually bad practice to preempt vul against non-vul with a weak suit, but have you discussed this with your partner?

Every trick is important at matchpoints but too many players merely try to make their contract without looking for those valuable overtricks. Here is a hand when declarer missed an easy opportunity.

BIDDING: The auction started quietly enough until North jumped to the four-level. East wasn't sure who could make what but he raised his partner and then South closed the auction.

PLAY: With no attractive lead, West settled on the ace of clubs. This delighted South who quickly trumped in dummy, drew trumps, and claimed eleven tricks conceding a heart and a diamond. If he had slowed down a bit he would have realized there was a good chance of setting up dummy's heart suit for a diamond discard. With the opponents' hearts dividing 3-3 this would have been simple. In a small, local game two pairs made six while four pairs took only eleven tricks. Another was doubled in four and found only one overtrick and the last pair called a wrong card and went down in five spades. This hand should not be that difficult.

It takes a diamond lead to hold the contract to eleven tricks but I can't believe the lead was found from Q2. It's difficult to succeed at matchpoints if you use rubber bridge methods.

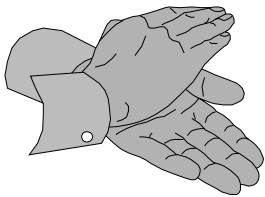

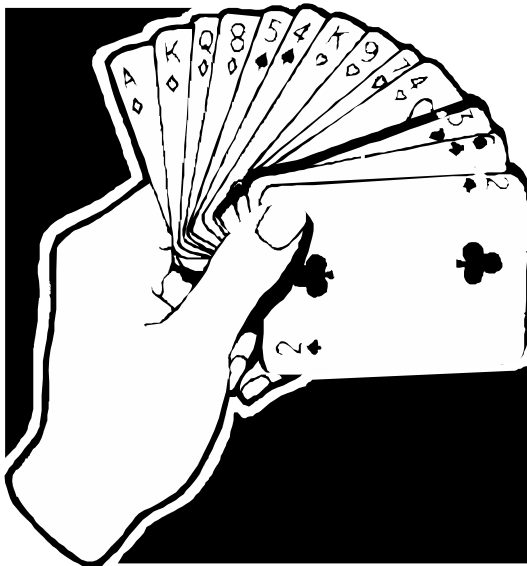
