Many players are too quick to bid notrump. Often the auction will offer information as to which player should declare.

**BIDDING:** West made a light overcall and North stopped to consider his call. The strength and shape of his hand suggested 3NT but the spade overcall made North wonder if the king was enough to stop the suit. Rather than make an immediate decision, he sought his partner's input. The spade cue bid showed a limit or better (10+) hand with club support. Holding a solid opener and two spade honors, South had no trouble bidding notrump and the game was reached.

**PLAY:** West led a spade that rode around to declarer's jack. It was now an easy task to establish clubs and hearts for ten tricks. At the other table in this team game, North jumped to 3NT over the spade overcall. East led a spade and when declarer mis-guessed clubs, he was defeated. North's hasty bid "wrong sided" the contract and he deserved his fate. Of course he could have succeeded by guessing to play West for the queen of clubs, but he should never have put the contract at risk.

If partner did not have help in the spade suit, North might still have arrived at 3NT, but there was no reason to make the final decision so soon.

While fourth down in your longest and strongest suit is often the best lead, you should pay attention to the auction before making that decision.

**BIDDING:** After North made a weak preference to diamonds, South finally showed extras by jumping to 3NT.

**PLAY:** I was sitting West and a club, the unbid suit, seemed the obvious lead. However, after reflecting on the auction I decided declarer was prepared for a club, likely holding three or four, and was probably short in hearts. (If he held a balanced hand, he would have opened 1NT or jumped to 2NT over the heart response.) I backed that hunch by putting the jack of hearts on the table. Declarer won the king as my partner encouraged with the deuce (upside-down signal). Next, declarer misplayed diamonds by starting with the ace from his hand and low toward dummy. He was now in trouble. He went up with the king of diamonds and took the losing club finesse into my hand. I continued with the nine of hearts and declarer rose with dummy's ace. Next he led a low spade to his ten allowing me to win and continue with my last heart. This gave us one spade, three hearts, two diamonds, and one club. A very flustered declarer had to enter down three on the score card.

Most N/S pairs made either nine or ten tricks in notrump after receiving a club lead. This declarer could have done better but the hand shows how important the auction is to the defense.

The auction is usually easier when you set the trump suit early. This hand is a good example.

**BIDDING:** At first South merely liked his hand but when his partner bid clubs, he fell in love with it. South raised and after two cue bids, North showed his semi balanced shape by bidding 3NT. This pair uses Minorwood where four of the agreed minor asks for keycards (4 aces + trump king). North showed three keycards and South bid the grand slam in notrump.

**PLAY:** West led a heart and declarer quickly claimed thirteen tricks. Many players in the South chair ignored clubs electing instead to show their good spade suit. North raised to the spade game and, worried about diamonds, several of the South players passed. It's true South should move past the spade game, but his failure to support clubs earlier created the problem. As this hand shows, raising a minor does not mean you cannot play in another strain.

#4

Defense is perhaps the most difficult part of this great game, but sometimes common sense is all you need. Here is a hand where a defender knew what to do but failed to follow through.

BIDDING: North-South had a routine auction to game.

PLAY: West led the queen of hearts and East followed with the six expecting his partner to continue the suit. After declarer played the deuce, West thought his partner was discouraging hearts and, worried about the good diamond suit in dummy, switched to the ace of clubs. This was fatal to the defense, a point quickly made by East. However, it was East who erred. It should have been clear the defense needed club tricks along with the two heart tricks. He should have overtaken the queen of hearts to put the club queen on the table. The defense would quickly wrap up four tricks leaving declarer very sad. Instead when they compared results with their teammates, they had to say "Lose twelve IMPs".

When you know what is right, don't depend upon partner to see the it also; just do it!

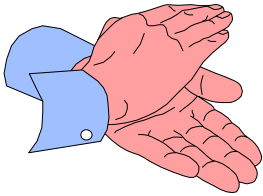

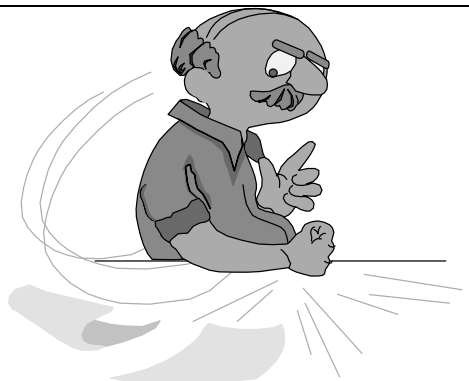

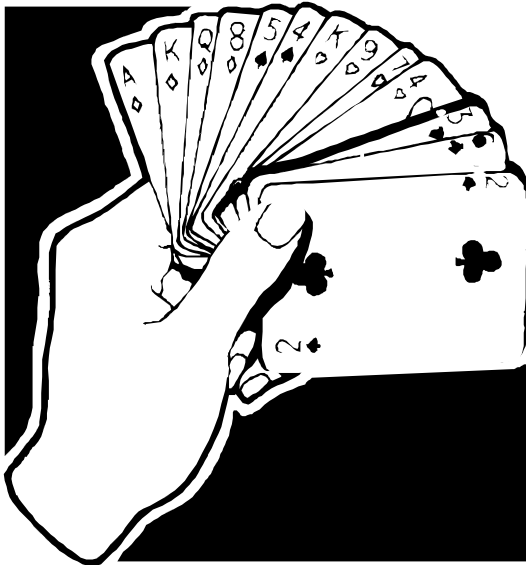
