What exactly is a "solid" suit? The declarer in this hand was missing the jack and it came back to beat him.

BIDDING: North's diamond response was forcing to game. South's unnecessary jump in spades promised a solid suit and set trumps. North used Roman Keycard Blackwood to discover South held three of the five keycards (4 aces + spade king) and confidently bid the slam.

PLAY: West led the ace of hearts and later won a trick with the jack of spades. North was understandably upset and pointed out that with the favorable diamond situation, slam would make in either diamonds or notrump. The jack of spades was pleased to finally receive the credit he felt he deserved.

This may have been an unlucky hand for declarer but solid should mean solid. Many partnerships use this jump to show a suit that will have only one loser opposite a singleton.

Sometimes it's not clear if a contract is bid to make or if it's an attempted sacrifice. It's often right to bid one more just to be safe. With this hand, neither side was sure who could make what.

BIDDING: South had a maximum hand for his diamond overcall. West, holding seven high card points plus a use void, cue bid diamonds to show a good raise for his partner's suit. North knew his partner would not make a weak vulnerable overcall so he offered a raise. East wasn't sure who could make what so she bid one more. At first South thought about doubling but it sure sounded like the opponents had a void in diamonds so he also bid one more. With no aces, East made a questionable double of the final contract.

PLAY: West led a low spade won by declarer. A quick look at the hand offered declarer a winning play. At trick two he led the jack of clubs to East's king. East cashed a spade and shifted to a low heart but it was too late. Declarer won the ace, went to dummy with a club, and took the diamond finesse. A second round of trumps picked up the king and all declarer had to do was lead another diamond to dummy and discard his two heart losers on the good clubs.

The contract could be defeated by an original heart lead. The opponents' spade contract could be defeated by the unlikely lead of a low heart or ace and another heart. Then when in with the spade ace, South can give North a heart ruff. This was certainly an interesting hand.

Sometimes the most simple play can be overlooked. Here is a hand where the establishment of an extra overtrick was missed.

BIDDING: South's 2NT opening showed 20-21 high card points. North used Stayman to check for a possible heart fit and then signed off in game.

PLAY: West led a low heart won by declarer with the ten. Declarer played the ace and queen of diamonds to make sure that suit behaved and counted 3 spades, 1 heart, 4 diamonds and 2 club tricks. Without enough thought, declarer played two more diamonds and then took the losing club finesse. West won the queen and exited with a club to wait for two more heart tricks. With the nine of hearts in dummy, declarer missed an easy play for this eleventh trick. He should just concede his king and jack of hearts and the nine becomes the second overtrick. This simple play was missed by over half of the N/S pairs.

While defense can often be difficult, sometimes it's simply a matter of cashing your tricks. Here is hand where one got away.

BIDDING: South had a choice of responding 1NT or making a negative in case his partner held four hearts. North's 3S bid asked South to bid 3NT if he held a spade stopper and South obliged.

PLAY: West the queen and another spade to East's king. Rather than cash the spade ace and set up two tricks for declarer, East switched to a low diamond. Declarer ran six club tricks and then cashed the ace of hearts. When the king fell, declarer had eleven tricks: 2 hearts, 3 diamonds, and 6 clubs. Looking at dummy, the danger of the third defensive trick vanishing was certainly possible so East should have grabbed it while he could.

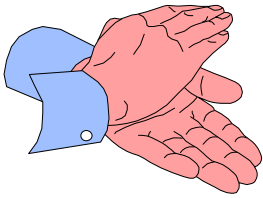

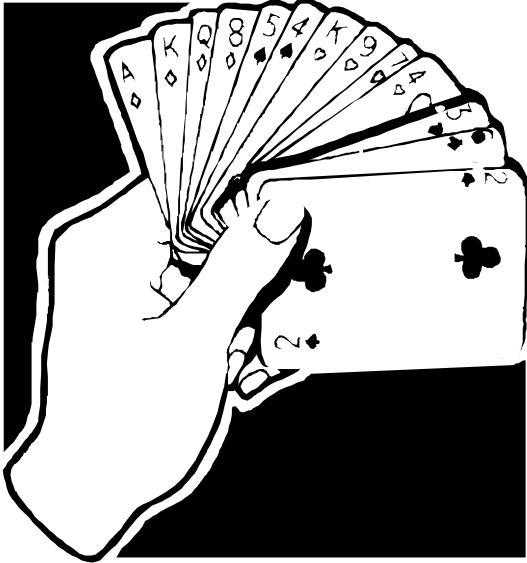
